who can participate?

Anyone who is interested in joining for an evening of fun and fresh air. No experience is necessary. Lessons are available for an extra cost (\$49 for first person and \$25 for each additional person) but numbers and type of lesson must be confirmed at least 3 days before our arrival.



When?

- Our first trip will be **Thursday February 8th**. Listen to morning announcements for future dates.
- Our trips will always take place on Wednesday or Thursday evenings because of 2 for 1 pricing on equipment and rentals.
- A bus will transport all students to Brookvale, leaving the school between 3:45-4:00. The bus will return to Stonepark at 9:00pm sharp. Please inform your parent/guardian.

what is the cost?

2-for-1 nights are Wednesdays and Thursdays. Students will pay the following:

- Student lift ticket (\$8)
- Student rental pkg (skis, boots, poles, helmet) (\$11)
 Total price including taxes = \$21.85
 - * Students will pay Brookvale directly for lift ticket and rentals.
- Ms. Horrelt will collect \$5 bus fee on day of trip.

Can I bring my own equipment?

- If you have your own equipment, you are encouraged to bring it; however, equipment cannot be transported on the bus. Our chaperones will make sure your equipment arrives safely to the hill. When you sign up, it is important to indicate whether you are renting or have you own equipment.
- Equipment can be brought to school the morning of, or dropped off after school. We will store students' equipment during the school day.
- Helmets are mandatory, and are included in the price of your rental.

Forms and money:

- Sign up in advance, outside Ms. Horrelt's door. Deadline to sign up for the first trip is end of the day on Tuesday (February 6th).
- *High Risk permission form (one form covers all trips)*
- Rental agreement. Must be signed by an adult with ID (driver's license). Rental agreements are needed for each trip.
- *Ms. Horrelt will collect the bus fee on day of trip.*
- Bring money for rentals, lift tickets, bus, and canteen.
- See Ms. Horrelt to pick up forms.

What do I need to bring?

- Warm jacket, snow pants, mittens and hat. Dress in layers if possible.
- High Risk permission form (pass in prior to trip)
- Rental agreement form (pass in prior to trip)
- Money for rentals, lift tickets, bus, and canteen.
- Positive attitude and respectful behavior.



Friendly Reminders

- We are ambassadors for Stonepark Intermediate and visitors to the Mark Arendz Ski Park. We WANT to be welcomed back.
- We will respect the people we encounter, the equipment we rent, and the facility.
- Appropriate behavior is expected on the bus and on the hill during extra-curricular activities.
- Failure to comply with these expectations will lead to students losing privileges and not participating in future trips.
