Transportation

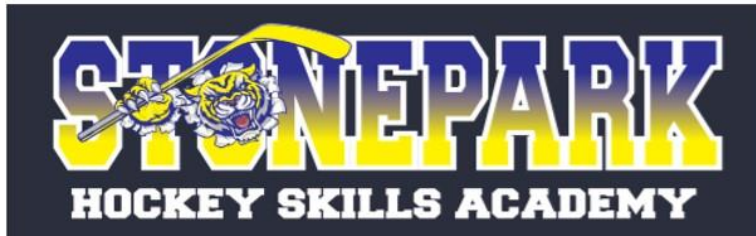
- Students can depart Stonepark at the end of 4th period 1:48pm
