Demographics

- Stonepark is the largest Intermediate school in PEI
- Combination of urban and rural students
- Over 800 people in the building (760 students)
- Housed by Grade Level Grade 7 has its own Vice-Principal
- Approximately 250 Grade 7s in September
 - 3 Programs CFI, LFI, English



7 Things about Stonepark

- Great school outstanding teaching staff
- 2 Admin. Assistants, 2 Custodians, 4 Cleaners
- 3 Phys. Ed. teachers, 5-6 Specialists teachers
- Many opportunities for students (clubs, teams, etc)
- Different services... Youth worker, counsellor, addictions services, extra help, support groups
- Increasingly diverse school
- High expectations (academics & behaviour)

A typical day at Stonepark

(Which may not be typical in September)

- Grade 7s go to the cafeteria upon arrival
- Homeroom bell at 8:25
- 8:30 O'Canada & announcements
- Five 60-minute periods
- Break 9:37-10:50
- Lunch begins around noon
- Homeroom at 12:45
- Day ends at 2:53
- Buses depart at 3:02

- 2-3 Educational Assistants




Break and Lunch

- Students stay in the school during break but are allowed outside at lunch time, but <u>not off the school property</u>.
- Students can purchase lunch in the cafeteria or bring a packed lunch.
- Families can also order from the PEI Healthy School Program
- After students eat lunch, they can stay in the cafeteria, the games room, library, the gym or go outside.

Teachers

- Students may have 4-7 teachers.
- The subjects in Grade 7 include:
 - Math
 - Science
 - Social Studies
 - Language Arts
 - Core French
 - Physical Education & Health
 - Specialists Woods, Ceramics, Foods & Art, or Band



Cafeteria

- The school cafeteria is open in the morning the Bagel Barn is located there - free breakfast.
- All grade sevens go to the cafeteria in the morning and wait there until the 8:25 bell signals it's time to go to class.
- The cafeteria specials are announced in the morning and posted on the school website.
- Students should always use a tray while in the cafeteria, and clean up their mess when they are finished.

Lockers

- Students will have a small locker for the year, keep it neat!
- They will receive a lock with a 3 digit combination lock.
- Students will be given their lock in June this year it's theirs for the 3 years they are at Stonepark.
- Locker will be assigned by the homeroom teacher.
- Lost locks are \$10 to replace.
